The Van Buren County Commission met in a Regular Meeting on April 16, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. at the Van Buren County Administrative Facility & Justice Center. The following action was taken as recorded in Minute Book, "T".

Call to Order

Deputy Cameron Clendenon called the Meeting to Order.

Committee B Meeting April 11, 2024

Roll Call: All members were in attendance except Michael Woodlee

Piney Convenience Center and Used Automotive Fluid Center: Committee B discussed advertising two bids. One is for concrete pad 6"x12'x70' with rebar and fiber. The second one is for a 14'x40'x40' pole barn. Michael Chandler made a motion for Committee B to proceed with advertising those bids. It was seconded by Kenny Smith and all members were in favor.

New Veterans Officer: Committee B received three applications for the Veterans Officer position. Applications will be reviewed, and applicants will be asked to come back for an interview. Committee B scheduled the interview for April 18 at 6 p.m.

New Business: Sheriff Brock brought to Committee B's attention 5 patrol cars needing to be removed and disposed of. Sheriff Brock presented two options to the Committee. First was to sell them online through Gov Deals. He mentioned it would take time, resources, and money to get these vehicles ready to auction. Also, there is no guarantee of how much they would bring. Second was to take the vehicles to the scrap yard. Sheriff Brock contacted Scotts Auto Salvage in Sparta, TN. They gave him an estimation the vehicles would bring \$2,200.00. It would cost Sheriff Brock \$200.00 to get them hauled to the salvage yard. Sheriff Brock would go to the salvage yard and witness them being crushed. Michael Chandler made a motion to allow the

vehicles to be taken off to the scrap yard. Kenny Smith seconded the motion, and all members were in favor.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Michael Chandler to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Kenny Smith. All members were in favor.

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CHAPTER 38 OF THE PRIVATE ACTS OF 2024 TO REPEAL CHAPTER 111 OF THE PRIVATE ACTS OF 1986

WHEREAS, Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1986 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee established a requirement for competitive bidding for all purchases and contracts for purchases of supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services in the amount of \$2,500.00 or greater, which Act was approved by a two-thirds (2/3^{rds}) vote of the Board of County Commissioners for Van Buren County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 38 of the Private Acts of 2024 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee repeals Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1986 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, effective upon approval by a two-thirds (2/3^{rds}) vote of the Board of County Commissioners for Van Buren County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Van Buren County, Tennessee hereby desires to approve Chapter 38 of the Private Acts of 2024 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee so as to repeal the provisions of Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1986 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners for Van Buren County, Tennessee hereby approves Chapter 38 of the Private Acts of 2024 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee and by virtue thereof does hereby repeal Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1986 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee.

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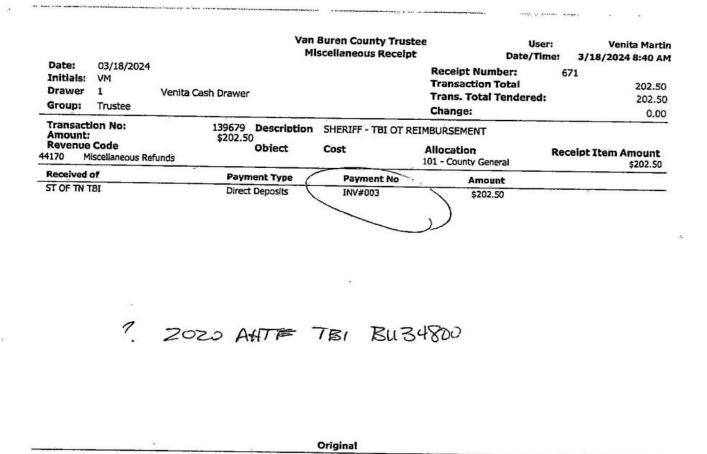

Proposed Collection Policy

Patient accounts will be placed in collection status after 90 days with no response from the patient or no payment. During that 90 days at least 3 letters shall be sent and one (1) phone call made if a phone number is available. The accounts in collection status will be sent to a collection agency directly from the billing agency. The ambulance service will contract with a collection agency to provide this service. The county attorney will review any contract prior to being signed.

Accounts which the collection agency determines to be collectable through court will be approved by the Director prior to scheduling court dates.

Van Buren County Ambulance Service employees will make every attempt to obtain patient signatures (depending on the patient's condition) at the time of service. The patient signature will acknowledge.

I authorize the submission of a claim for payment to Medicare, Medicaid, or any other payor for any services provided to me by VBCEMS now, in the past, or in the future, until such time as I revoke this authorization in writing. I understand that I am financially responsible for the services and supplies provided to me by VBCEMS, regardless of my insurance coverage, and in some cases, may be responsible for an amount in addition to that which was paid by my insurance. I agree to immediately remit to VBCEMS any payments that I receive directly from insurance or any source whatsoever for the services provided to me and I assign all rights to such payments to VBCEMS. I authorize VBCEMS to appeal payment denials or other adverse decisions on my behalf without further authorization. I authorize and direct any holder of medical information or other relevant documentation about me to release such information to VBCEMS and its billing agents, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, and/or any other payors or insurers, and their respective agents or contractors, as may be necessary to determine these or other benefits payable for any services provided to me by VBCEMS, now, in the past, or in the future. I also understand that if I do not pay my bill the amount owed will be sent to collections and I will be responsible for any necessary costs of collections.

After the collection agency determines an account to be uncollectable, the Director will prepare a list for the County Commission to approve as "uncollectable write-offs" per the write-off policy.
